

MISSIONS HEADLINES

Our June Mission Focus will be John Calvin Presbytery. JCP is what is called a middle governing body in the PC(USA). That means that as a church, we are a member of JCP and a member of the larger church called the PC(USA). Part of the mission of JCP is to provide ways for churches to minister to not only congregations and to the communities where they exist. As a ministry to congregations, one focus of JCP is spiritual growth. In order to help promote spiritual growth, JCP has a portable prayer labyrinth that it loans to churches. Presently, the prayer labyrinth is in one of the classrooms at Trinity and members are encouraged to read the scriptures on the walls of the Fellowship Hall and the Family Worship Room in preparation for walking the prayer labyrinth. There will be instructions in the classroom to guide you on your walk. We hope you will take advantage of this opportunity to try a prayer labyrinth as a part of your spiritual growth here at Trinity.
